The TMSA Event Calendar remains the only annual publication concentrating on traditional / folk music events and activity across Scotland, with its distribution enabling you to publicise your events both to a domestic and international audience with standard and enhanced listings, and adverts this year at very cost effective prices – comparable to what you would pay to have a single small ad in a monthly magazine with a smaller circulation!

We are currently compiling the edition to go out around Scotland and beyond to England, Wales, Northern Ireland and Dublin - trialled pre-Covid, along with digital marketing through the TMSA website and social media reaching 60,000+ people.

Also we advertise our online presence in a number of publications as a source to find out about events and activity so your listings/adverts have a greater chance of being seen. For example we are continuing with our advertising in the Landmark Press 'Welcome to Scotland Guide' - which has **800,000 copies** being picked up by visitors and locals. # We have three groupings of listings in the format of the Calendar:

- 1. Chronological events in date order arranged loosely in seasons
- 2. Folk Clubs & Sessions
- 3. General network organisations, trad music related businesses, venues or groups that run regular traditional music activity on a regular basis e.g. classes.

## Affiliate Entry £70 (Standard) / £110 (Enhanced):

If you join as a TMSA affiliate member (only £30), you will get an Enhanced Listing plus:

- Access to a free media release service about your Event/ Folk Club this would normally cost you at least £60 if you paid for this service on a one-off basis.
- We will use our Facebook (currently over 2000 followers) and Twitter (over 1000 followers) accounts to further promote your listing details.
- Opportunity to put publicity material into one of the TMSA's membership mailing electronic
   & postal for free as long as it doesn't cause us to go over the standard postage rate.

Advertisers qualify for a free Enhanced Listing in the Event Calendar. We can create adverts for you if you need this service. This is set at £100 an advert regardless of size. We may also charge an amendment fee for adverts which are not supplied ready to be used in the Event Calendar without further designer time.

### Sponsorship of the TMSA Event Calendar

The option is still available to sponsor the whole brochure publication including online. If this option is of interest to you, please contact us as soon as possible, to discuss details and levels of sponsorship.

### Please note:

Wherever possible, we prefer to have payment when supplying the information for your entry but we are able to issue invoices and receipts if this helps with your paperwork! Sometimes we can consider reciprocal advertising options - please contact us if you are in a position to offer us this option.
